Pagoda Village Everett is a mixed-use project consisting of 220 apartments, and 44,000 SF of retail space for restaurants, shops and a year round Farmers' Market. The material palate pays homage to agricultural roots while acknowledging a industrial present. Architectural elements are wrapped in reclaimed lumber, paving patterns conjure images of agricultural plots viewed from Boeing jetliner, display niches house farming related artifacts. The project is much more than the sum of its parts. It is a valuable community asset that re-invigorates a neighborhood, provides a place for a diverse community to come together, celebrates the past, embraces the future, and respects the environment.
